## AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE 3.0, SECTIONS 3.02 AND 3.03, OF THE STANDING RULES:

3.02

Any alleged breach of this code of conduct shall be reported in writing to the Chair President of the Portage County Young Democrats. Any allegation made against the Chair President shall be referred to the Sergeant-At-Arms.

3.03

Upon receipt of an alleged violation of this policy, the Chair President or Sergeant-At-Arms shall, within forty-eight (48) hours, alert the Executive Committee to the allegations being presented.

If a reporting deadline falls on the weekend or federal holiday, the Chair President or Sergeant-At-Arms shall have until the close of the next business day to submit their claim.

The Chair President or Sergeant-At-Arms shall appoint a three-person panel to investigate allegations, determine their validity, and to make appropriate suggestions for corrective action.

## **AMENDED TEXT IF ADOPTED:**

3.02

Any alleged breach of this code of conduct shall be reported in writing to the President of the Portage County Young Democrats. Any allegation made against the President shall be referred to the Sergeant-At-Arms.

## 3.03

Upon receipt of an alleged violation of this policy, the President or Sergeant-At-Arms shall, within forty-eight (48) hours, alert the Executive Committee to the allegations being presented.
